

VILLAGE HALL UPDATE FOR DECEMBER 16, 2016

Village Board Meeting in Review

At the November 15th Board meeting the Board approved:

- A resolution awarding the sale of \$1,295,000 in taxable general obligation community development bonds. These bonds are to be used for Tax Incremental District 4 (Apartment Complex).
- An intergovernmental agreement to provide police and fire dispatching services to the Village of Hales Corners. The Village of Greendale will begin dispatching for Hales Corners in 2017.
- An agreement with EMS Medical Billing Associates to continue providing billing services for the Village of Greendale.
- An agreement with the Village of Hales Corners to share the Village of Greendale's paramedic license.

The Board discussed, but did not act on the following items: water and sewer rate increases, service fees for basic lift support and advanced life support, purchases of furniture, equipment, technology for the new Fire Station. These items will be brought back at the December 20th meeting for discuss and possible action.

December 20th Village Board Meeting Preview

A public hearing will be held for the special use request to construct a wireless tower facility at 6101 S. 51st Street (St. Stephen the Martyr Lutheran Church). This item was scheduled to be reviewed by the Plan Commission on December 14th, but due to a request from the applicant will be delayed until the January 11th Plan Commission meeting. The public hearing on December 20th will be adjourned and continued at the January 17th Board meeting.

The Board will review a request from St. Alphonsus to demolish and rebuild the church rectory. This item will likely be referred to the January 11th Plan Commission meeting for review and recommendation.

The Board will review items from the December 6th meeting and potentially take action on these items at this meeting. These items include an increase in water utility, local sanitary and metro sanitary rates, as well as service fees for basic and advanced life support and purchases for the new Fire Station.

The Board will consider a request from the Library Board to amend the meeting room use policy at the Community Learning Center and a parade permit application from the American Diabetes Association for a Tour de Cure (a bike ride that travels through various communities on July 22nd).

Village Board Meeting in Review

At the November 15th Board meeting the Board approved:

- The 2017 Budget and tax levy with a 1% tax levy increase from 2016.
- An amendment to the agreement with US Cellular to use a portion of the Village's elevated storage tank.
- A redevelopment agreement with the JCPenney Corporation for their store at 5300 S. 76th Street.
- The acquisition of an easement near the intersection of Northway/Grange Avenue.

December 6th Village Board Meeting Preview

The Board will review a request from T-Mobile to place a tower at 6101 S. 51st Street (St. Stephen the Martyr Lutheran Church). This item will likely be forwarded to the Plan Commission for review and recommendation at their December 14th meeting.

- A resolution approving the sale of \$1,315,000 in taxable general obligation community development bonds regarding project costs in the Village's Tax Incremental District No. 4.
- An agreement with the Village of Hales Corners for the Village of Greendale to provide police and fire dispatching for Hales Corners.
- An agreement with a billing service for handling emergency medical service user fees.
- To review and discuss a staff proposal to increase Fire Department basic life support and advanced life support service fees.
- To review and discuss items needed to be purchased for the new Fire Station, such as furniture, equipment, technology, security, etc.
- To review and discuss a potential increase to the Village's water and sanitary sewer rates.

The Board will also review an intergovernmental agreement with Hales Corners for sharing the Village of Greendale's paramedic license.

The Board will go into closed to discuss the development at 6200 W. Loomis Road.

The first Tuesday of the month's Board meeting will be for items to be discussed, but not action unless necessary. The items will be brought back to the 2nd meeting of the month for action.
- A Veteran's Day Parade scheduled for Saturday November 12th beginning at 9:00 a.m. The route will begin at the Municipal Parking Lot and end at the site of the future Veteran's Memorial on Broad Street and Southway.
- An intergovernmental agreement between the City of Franklin and Village of Greendale to jointly use a 1994 Pierce Saber Fire Engine as a reserve engine.
- A special community event for "Hallowings at the Gazebo" a pumpkin carving event scheduled for October 22 – October 30 at the Gazebo. The pumpkins will be displayed on bleachers after they are carved. This event is hosted by Greendale Park and Recreation and the Gift of Wings store.

The parade permit was denied due to concerns regarding traffic and noise from other events held at the Rock Sports Complex and due to there being another parade in Greendale at the same time and day.
