

**Water Utility Customers
Notice of Rate Increase
Filed Under Wis. Stat. 196.193**

On July 1, 2010 the Village of Greendale Water Utility will file an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) for authorization to increase its water rates. General service as well as public fire protection and wholesale rates will increase by 3 percent (3%). This adjustment is necessary to reduce deficiencies in the existing fees. Rate modifications granted under this statute do not require a public hearing. The effect of the increase for some selected customers is shown below.

Industrial	2"	450,000	\$855.30	\$879.90
