pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(c), Wisconsin State Statutes to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, and

pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(g), Wisconsin State Statutes, to confer with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved, and

pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a), Wisconsin State Statutes, to deliberate concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body,

specifically, the request to discuss the request of the Attorney for Lt. Peterson to reconsider the decision filed June 26, 2017.

5. The Commission will return to open session to take action on those matters discussed in closed session specifically to discuss the request of the Attorney for Lt. Peterson to reconsider the decision filed June 26, 2017.
