Village Hall Update for November 14, 2014

Village Board Meeting in Review

At the November 4th Board meeting the Board reviewed the Fire Station Needs Analysis and determined they would move forward with planning for construction of a new building as opposed to remodeling the existing station. The staff is going to analyze three site options, the current Fire Station site, the Safety Center and a vacant lot owned by the State on the Southeast corner of Loomis and Grange and bring back information at a future meeting.

The Board also approved the 2015 events for the Milwaukee County Historical Society for the Historic Timeline Event and the Harvest of Arts and Crafts.

November 18, 2014 Village Board Meeting Preview

A public hearing is scheduled for the special use application to build a new detached garage at 6406 Conifer Lane. The Plan Commission recommended approval of this time at their November 12th meeting.

The Board will review a proposed intergovernmental cooperation agreement with Milwaukee County for maintenance of land records software and a special event application for the Dickens of a Christmas event.

Canterbury Heights Downtown Greendale Revitalization Project

****The earliest date that the Village Board would consider action on this project is November 4, 2014.**

For more than two years, the Village of Greendale has been exploring ways to build on the strength of and encourage even greater energy and investment in our historic downtown. As part of that effort, the Village Board recently encouraged the Community Development Authority (CDA) to provide recommendations on ways to:

- Celebrate our National Historic Landmark (NHL) designation;
- Energize our downtown area; and
- Move forward with the Historic Downtown Greendale Ad Hoc Committee's priority recommendations for how to improve the downtown area.

In response, the CDA started the public process of exploring the creation of a Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) District. By offering TIF financing for the development of new, high-end market rate apartments, the Village will have the tools to attract developers while also providing a funding mechanism to address the Historic Downtown Greendale Ad Hoc Committee's top recommendations for improving the downtown area, including:

- Redirecting the middle school drop-off;
- Making aesthetic improvements to the parking lot area, including creating a family-friendly park space;
- Renovating the exterior of the Hose Tower;
- Creating and enhancing linkages throughout the downtown area;
- Creating alternate residential options; and
- Incorporates the police/fire building.

About Tax Incremental Financing

Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) is an economic development tool used by municipalities to leverage private investments in real estate developments. Through TIF, the City invests in a new project and repays the investment through the new tax revenue generated by the new development. The result is greater development for the city, increased tax base and, when the TIF is paid off, enhanced tax revenue for the general fund.

It is important to note that Greendale homeowners and businesses owners will not pay one additional penny in new taxes to support TIF developments. The initial investment is repaid through the new taxes generated by the incremental increase in property value. This new property value would not exist, but for the new investment in the property.

To further clarify, the base taxes paid by any property with the TIF district will be the same whether or not the TIF is implemented.

Village Board Meeting in Review

At the July 15th Board meeting the Board approved the following items:

- The special use application from Goodwill to make exterior alterations to site building elevations, entrances and signage to their corporate headquarters at 5400 S. 60th. After construction is complete they plan to move employees to the new site in 2 phases beginning around January 15, 2015.
- A change to the traffic controls at the Southway intersection with Broad Street. A stop sign was added to Broad Street to make that intersection an all way stop. The change was made based on a traffic study that was completed at that site, which recommended it be converted to an all way stop.
- The language for the referendum question that will be placed on the November 4th ballot. “Should the polling places for the Village of Greendale be located in buildings other than in schools owned by the Greendale School District?” An explanation for the question will be published prior to the election.
- The Board also set preliminary meetings for the Committee of the Whole to meet regarding the 2015 Budget: Thursday October 23, Tuesday October 28 and Thursday October 30.

August 5, 2014 Village Board Meeting Preview
