

You may claim the Lottery and Gaming credit for 2016 property taxes, payable in 2017, if on January 1, 2016, you were the owner of the property and used the property as your primary residence. You can have only one primary residence. You cannot claim this credit on business property, rental units, land, garages or other properties that are not your primary residence. A non-Wisconsin resident cannot claim this credit.

If the property qualified as your primary residence on January 1, 2016, submit this completed form to your **County Treasurer**. The credit will appear on your 2016 property tax bill.
