Sunday, July 4th – Immediately following the parade

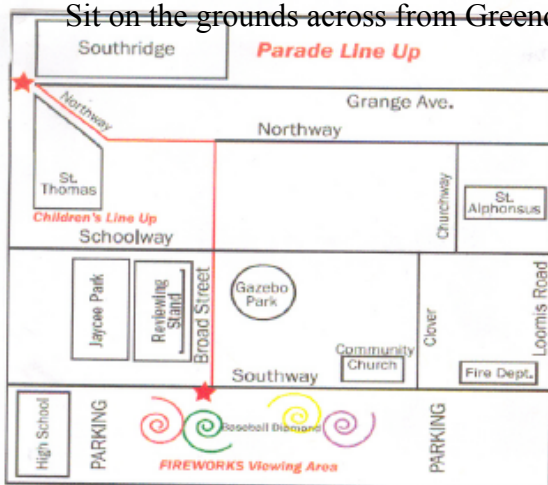
